



Congressman Tom Suozzi's Support for Israel and the Jewish Community

"I have always been and will continue to be a strong supporter of the U.S.-Israel alliance and the Jewish community"

- Introduced H.R. 6829 – Expanding Medical Partnerships with Israel to Lessen Dependence on China Act – which would create a U.S.-Israel grant program to promote key innovative solutions to COVID-19 and other health problems
- Introduced and passed the bipartisan H.R. 3342 SHIELDS Act which imposes sanctions on Hezbollah for its use of civilians as human shields
- Vocal opponent of the anti-Israel, anti-peace, BDS campaign against Israel which seeks to undermine and ultimately destroy the Jewish State
- Stood with Israel against discrimination from the International Criminal Court (ICC) which has wrongly sought to prosecute the U.S. and Israel
- Strongly supported extending the U.N. Arms Embargo Against Iran, which would prevent Iran from importing heavy weaponry, further enabling Iranian aggression and destabilization in the region
- A nuclear-capable Iran is a grave threat to U.S. national security as well as Israel. It is essential that the United States lead the effort to prevent one of the most dangerous countries in the world from having the most lethal weapons
- Introduced H.R. 328 – “Commemorating the 50th anniversary of the reunification of Jerusalem”
- Will never politicize the U.S.-Israel relationship by placing conditions on security assistance
- Visited Israel as Congressman and County Executive
- Supported and strongly promoted the bipartisan “Never Again Education Act” which expands U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum education programming
- Cosponsored H.R. 221 which established the Special Envoy for Monitoring and Combating anti-Semitism
