DCCC - NEW: Mazi Pilip Spends Day In DC Ducking Questions on Abortion

Mazi Pilip isn't just spending today in DC cozying up to her extreme Republican Party bosses – she's also continuing to duck questions on abortion.

Asked if she would support voting to codify Roe v. Wade nationwide, Pilip's staffer interjected and said, "No, sorry":
